Loans will be given for the creation, retention, and expansion of small private business enterprises based on the following priorities:

- Natural resource based enterprises
- Value-added agricultural enterprises
- Enterprises providing needed facilities and services to low-income, under employed, or the elderly
- Small commercial or retail businesses

- Maximum 10-year term

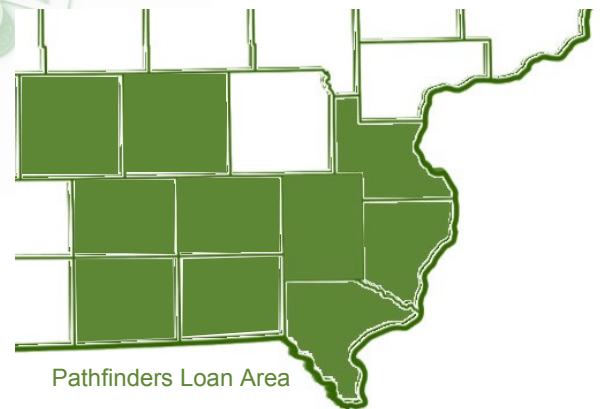
